6. Seven clear days' written notice shall be given to each member of the Annual or any General Meeting.

7. At any General Meeting nine members personally present to form a quorum. Any member unable to be present at any General Meeting may, by proxy signed by him, appoint any other member to represent him at such meeting. The proxy to be handed in to the Chairman at the meeting.

8. Candidates for election shall be proposed and seconded by members in writing, and shall be balloted for at the first meeting of the Committee, two adverse votes to exclude. If elected, the candidate shall, on payment of the subscription and entrance fee, become a member.

9. (a) The annual subscription for full members shall be—For ladies and gentlemen, 10s. Entrance fee—Ladies, nil; gentlemen, 10s. Non-playing members—Ladies, 10s; gentlemen, 10s. All subscriptions and entrance fees payable in advance. No member shall be allowed to use the Tennis Courts until they have paid their subscriptions for the then current year. Subscriptions to become due on 1st May in each year. (b) Playing members only to have the privilege of voting.

10. Any member requested to resign, in accordance with the votes of three-fourths of the members present at a General Meeting, convened in accordance with Rules 5, 6, and 7, shall cease to be a member, and shall forfeit subscriptions and all privileges of the Club.

11. Subject to the control of the Committee, members may occasionally, by giving three days' notice to the Secretary, introduce friends, who are non-residents of Hunters Hill, to play, provided no member of the Club is thereby excluded from playing.

12. The same playing friend to be introduced not more than once in every month, and not more than three playing friends to be introduced on Saturdays and holidays.

13. Visitors, non-resident of Hunters Hill, may be elected Honorary Members for one month, subject to the approval of Committee.

14. The Rules for the guidance of the game shall be those adopted by the N.S.W. Lawn Tennis Association.

15. The Committee may close or reserve the courts when in their opinion it is advisable to do so.

16. All disputes shall be referred to the Committee of the Club, whose decisions shall be final.

17. No one shall be allowed to play on the courts unless wearing boots or shoes without heels, and with india-rubber soles, or spikes as allowed by the Sydney L. T. Club.

18. No court shall be used by a set of players for more than one set, should there be any other members waiting to play; a set to consist of the best of 11 games.

19. The days of play to be Wednesdays, Saturdays, and holidays

20. Members of Committee present on ground shall have arranging of acts.

21. One court to be reserved for gentlemen only, on Saturdays and holidays.

22. No dogs shall be admitted into any part of the Club premises.

RULES

OF THE

Hunters Hill Lawn Tennis Club.

1. The Club shall be called "The Hunters Hill Lawn Tennis Club."

2. The Colors of the Club to be Red, Green and Silver.

3. (a) The management of the Club to be invested in a Committee to be elected by the members at the Annual General Meeting, to be held during the month of May in each year, such Committee to consist of six members, inclusive of the Hon. Secretary and Hon. Treasurer. Three to form a quorum. (b) A President to be elected annually.

4. The Club to be limited to thirty-six playing members.

5. Special General Meetings shall be called by the Secretary wh never directed by the Committee, or on a written requisition signed by not less than six members of the Club. Notice of such meeting to be given by circular, stating its objects, at least seven days previously, and discussion to be confined to the subject on the notice.

23. None of the above Rules shall be altered or amended except by three-fourths of the votes taken at a General Meeting, convened in accordance with Rules 5, 6, and 7.

24. Subject to the above rules, and any new rules or alterations made as before provided, the Committee shall have the entire management of the Club, and power to make or repeal by-laws.

25. The Committee shall have the power of joining any association or associations, and of arranging any match or matches which may be considered desirable.

26. No private matches shall be played on the Club courts without the consent of the Committee.
